**Chief's Report:** See <u>report</u> for a list of drills and responses. New recruit is under consideration, Cole Snell will be returning to the department.

## **Unfinished Business:**

- Land Donation—Karen will determine from the owner if the parcels are linked. Anya Mayo is following up with the potential buyers soon.
- Water Softener System—water has passed all three tests to date. Last month, Tom Fouts presented the information he has for a new water softener system for \$12,850.80, which will also include a reverse osmosis system \$852. Answer received from attorney Snure: This would be a public works project and is under the \$30,000 bid threshold so no issues with our process. The vendor will need to pay prevailing wages and comply with the public works requirements. Commissioner Murphy moved to approve the bid for the water softener, motion seconded, motion carried unanimously; the chief will proceed with the contract and make sure the wording from Brian Snure, attorney at law is included in the contract.

### New Business:

- 2023 Annual Report has been filed with the WA State Auditor.
- Levy Calculation Worksheet from Skagit County Assessor was discussed; how the levy is calculated. Skagit county has approved the language for our levy increase on the ballot;, Karen and Manuel are writing the pro statement; no one as come forward to produce the con opinion.
- BVFF fees for annual disability and pension payments increasing January 1, 2025: Disability increase from \$30 to \$50; Pension increase from \$60 to \$90; with our 15 volunteers at \$140 per member per year, or \$2,100 beginning in January 2025.
